Jack Youngs

Jack Youngs was born April 11 1927 in Albion, Pa. He spent several years as a Boy Scout in his early years. He graduated from Albion High School in 1945. After a tour of duty with the United States Air Force, he attended and graduated from Penn State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering.

Jack started as a field engineer with the Dravo Corporation located in Pittsburgh, PA where he stayed 8 years.

In 1959, Jack moved to Gassaway, WV and started G&L Constructors, Inc. He furnished construction services to clients and building industrial facilities; (20% industrial

plants, 10% municipal, 70% natural gas compressor stations.

In 1969 the company moved to Derwent, OH and changed the name of the company to G&L Services, Inc. G&L furnished construction and design services to the natural gas industry. In 1979, construction was no longer the primary function of the company so two separate companies were formed, Basic Systems, Inc. and Bi-Con Services, Inc.

Basic Systems, Inc. (BSI) is a multidiscipline, full service consulting engineering firm. They offer a full range of project, process, mechanical, electrical, instrumental, civil, structural, and automatic/systems control engineering as well as inspection, procurement, construction management and start-up services for the natural gas industry. BSI has the capability to design and construct either totally new projects or major upgrades, from the feasibility study state through facility start-up.

Bi-Con Services, Inc provides construction and manufacturing services to the natural gas industry. The manufacturing division manufactures pressure vessels (code and non-code), piping systems, control panels and systems, and assembled modular skids for oil, chemical, and gas facilities. The construction division provides services ranging from development and site work to assembling, fabricating, and erecting mechanical piping, structures, and equipment for the production, transmission, storage, and distribution of natural gas. The building division provides commercial and industrial construction.

In 1989, Jack traveled to Russia with the American Society of Civil Engineers and became interested in pursuing work internationally, concentrating on the former Soviet Union and Eastern Europe. He then formed a company to handle international projects. World Energy Services (WSE) was formed to market Basic Systems, Inc. and Bi-Con Services, Inc. worldwide. WSE provides marketing and feasibility studies, financing arrangements, training, and contract preparation for projects internationally. WSE has companies in Russia and Poland.

In 1999, ACI Services, Inc. was purchased. They provide manufactured products, engineered solutions, and performance software for reciprocating compressors. Products and services including customer compressor cylinders, unloading equipment, performance enhanced compressor components, interactive performance software and automation software.

Jack married Stephanie Grier in 1998 and has 3 stepchildren and 5 step-grandchildren. He also has 3 children and 6 grandchildren.

Since his retirement from Bi-Con and BSI, he has been active in the development of new products.
