

Arrowhead District Awards Description

District Award of Merit: This is the highest award a District can present to a Scouter. The nominee should be someone who has distinguished themselves among the adult volunteer through their service to the youth of the District. There are two awards given.

Scouter of the Year: This award is for the Boy Scout volunteer who shows exceptional dedication for his service to his/her Troop. The volunteer can hold any registered position in the unit. One award will be given.

Cub Scouter of the Year: This award is for the Cub Scout volunteer who shows exceptional dedication for his service to his/her Pack. The volunteer can hold any registered position in the unit. One award will be given.

Venturing Volunteer of the Year: This award is for the Venturing volunteer who shows exceptional dedication for his service to his/her Crew. The volunteer can hold any registered position in the unit. One award will be given.

District Volunteer of the Year: This award is presented to a volunteer of the District staff for outstanding service and dedication given to the District.

Commissioner of the Year: This award is presented to the Commissioner who exemplifies the duties and responsibilities inherent in the duties of exceptional unit service. All aspects of their performance should be taken into account.

Spirit of Scouting: This award is given to a youth in the Arrowhead District for exceptional dedication to Scouting while exemplifying the Scout Oath and Law in action.

Meritorious Service Award: This award is given to adult volunteers for their service to Scouting. This award is for dedicated service over a longer period of time. There are two awards given.

Order of The Heart: This award is reserved for those female volunteers who, in a relatively short period of time, have served the youth of their unit or District with distinction. There are up to four awards given.

Fellowship of the "A": This award is reserved for those male volunteers who, in a relatively short period of time, have served the youth of their unit or District with distinction. There are up to four awards given.

Super Scouter Service Award: This recognition is for individuals or companies within your communities that have gone above and beyond in their assistance of a local unit, or the Arrowhead District. The assistance may be financial, a gift of time, or other resources. This is your unit's opportunity to give thanks for community support.
