Father's Day marked the first day of Boy Scout Summer Camp at MVSR. The staff has worked hard to prepare all the program areas and set up the campsites. New this year, campers will find an awesome new Ecology Conservation Center complete with Bear (stuffed) snakes, turtles, and frogs. There is a new observation shack where scouts can observe nature including the many birds coming to the feeders that have been placed around the shack. In keeping with the Jurassic Camp theme, we have, on loan, several extraordinary fossils including a Mastodon tooth, and several pre historic trilobites. Also new this year, the STEM program has added the Engineering Merit Badge.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT THE SPECIALTY CAMPS BEING OFFERED THIS SUMMER:

MVSX - July 25-29, \$150 (\$100*)

This 5 day adventure includes a high ropes course and 50+ mile canoe trip from Loudonville to camp. Adventurers will also earn the 50 miler award.

POWER - July 25-28, \$125 (\$100*)

"Preserving Our World's Energy Resources". This 4 day camp will focus on the science and technology of energy. Scouts will visit the Conesville Power plant and the Three Rivers Ethanol plant. Scouts will work on completing Energy and Mining in Society Merit Badges.

BSA LIFEGUARD - July 25-31, \$125 (\$100*)

This 6-day intensive training camp is open to both youth and adults. Successful participants will come away with a nationally recognized Lifeguard certification. Strong swimming, rowing and canoeing skills are a must!
