## **ANNUAL UNIT RECHARTERING**

Every year every unit must renew their official 'charter' to operate from the Boy Scouts of America. This process, called rechartering, requires that the unit log-in to the rechartering system to indicate which youth and adults are being renewed for the coming year. The rechartering process must be complete by December 15<sup>th</sup> to ensure your unit does not lapse. By now, your unit leadership has received an email containing the proper log-in code. Once you have completed the simple, online process, you will be able to print out the recharter application. The application requires several signatures including the unit leader, and the head of your sponsoring organization (IH). We recommend you hold a brief recharter meeting with all the signers and your unit commissioner. Your commissioner will review the paperwork to ensure it is complete. Your IH signs the completed paperwork approving the leadership and validating the membership. This completed paperwork, and any additional leader or youth applications must be submitted to the council before December 15<sup>th</sup>. Each district will have a charter turn-in event at their December Roundtable meeting.

Our final project is the expansion and renovation of the Scouting Resource Center in Zanesville. The Scouting Resource Center is dated, lacks conference and storage space, and is not handicap accessible. Our Scouts and leaders deserve a first class facility.
