

Dayle Owen Snyder, M.D.

After earning his undergraduate degree in three years from Bradley University, Dayle O. Snyder attended medical school at the University of Illinois. He completed his internship as well as his surgical residence at Cook County Hospital, in Chicago.

Dr. Snyder moved to Cambridge in 1964 to begin his surgical practice with Dr. Merritt C. McCusky and Dr. Jesse B. Kellum. Soon after, Dr. Quentin F. Knauer joined the surgical group practice known as Ohio Physicians, Inc.

For 35 years, he has served as an active member of the Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center staff, and has held many offices there including member of the Board of Trustees.

Dr. Snyder has been active with Indian Guides, The Living Word, Cambridge Singers, and the Kiwanis Club of Cambridge, where he has served as president, lieutenant governor, and a member of the State Foundation.

He is also a trustee and choir member of the Ninth Street Methodist Church and board member and choir member of the Seventh Street Methodist Church. Dr. Snyder also served as session member twice and choir member of the New Concord College Drive Presbyterian Church.

Through the years, Dr. Snyder has continued his life-long love for scouting by serving since 1968 on the board of Muskingum Valley Council, Boy Scouts of America. He served as Council President in 1980 and 1981. Dr. Snyder has been honored with the Silver Beaver and Silver Antelope Awards, the highest awards given by the Council and the Region respectively. He volunteered his services as a National Jamboree Staff physician three times. Dr. Snyder truly showed his commitment to scouting when he organized 13 years ago the first fundraising banquet, which is now today as the Distinguished Citizen Banquet. Tonight's banquet has once again been a tremendous success raising nearly \$20,000 for Scouting.
