ANNUAL CHARTER RENEWAL

Annual Charter Renewal packets are being distributed to units beginning at your October Roundtable. Unit leaders should schedule a recharter meeting with the Charter Organization Representative and the Institutional Head. At that meeting you will determine what Scouts and leaders will be continuing. If everyone is at the meeting, you can get all the necessary signatures to complete the process. Every unit must recharter by December 31st, or their charter to operate will lapse on January 1st.

Now is also the time to be sure that all leaders have their Youth Protection Training up to date. No leader may be registered without being current in their Youth Protection Training. To complete the training, log on to your my.scouting account.
