From the National Council... "The new jamboree theme reinforces one of the Summit Bechtel Reserve's purposes of helping to redefine Scouting's adventure for the next century. Participants of the 2017 National Jamboree will experience that difference every day they are here," said Dan McCarthy, director of the Boy Scouts of America Summit Group. "Our goal is to give as many Scouts and Venturers as possible a chance to participate in this truly life-changing experience at this unique facility."

It is our Council's plan to send one full Troop (36 boys) and ½ of a Venture Crew (18-20youth) to the Jamboree in 2017. We can adjust those numbers if interest dictates. Preference will be given to boys ages 13 and up on the event date. Older Scouts may wish to attend the Jamboree as Venture Scouts and may easily do this with a dual registration in a Venture Crew. In the end, we want to maximize the number of youth that can participate from our Council. The Cost of the trip is projected to be between \$1200-1300. Details of the exact costs will be available in the spring of 2016. We recommend placing a \$100 deposit with the council as soon as you are able to commit to the trip.
